



GRADUATION RATE

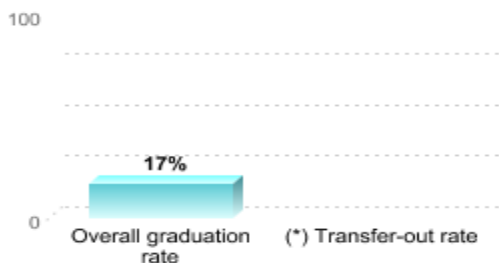
The overall graduation rate is also known as the “Student Right to Know” or IPEDS graduation rate. It tracks the progress of students who began their studies as full-time, first-time degree or certificate seeking students to see if they complete a degree or other award within 150% of the “normal time” to complete the program in which they are enrolled.

Note: Not all students at this College are tracked for these rates. Students who have already attended another postsecondary institution or who began their studies on a part-time basis, are not tracked for this rate.

SANDUSKY CAMPUS

Graduate rates measure the percentage of first-time students who graduated or transferred out within 150% of “normal time” to completion for their program.

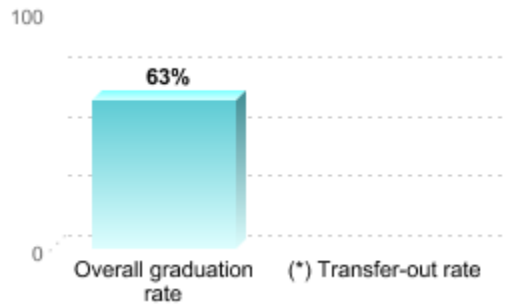


Percentage of Full-time, First-Time Students Who Graduated or Transferred Out Within 150% of "Normal Time" to Completion for Their Program
