



STATEMENT OF ACCREDITATION

Ohio Business College is accredited by the Accrediting Council for Independent Colleges and Schools (ACICS). On December 12, 2016, the Secretary of the Department of Education upheld a decision to end recognition of ACICS as a recognized accreditor. Colleges and universities accredited by ACICS will have 18 months (until June 12, 2018) to obtain accreditation from a different accreditor in order to maintain eligibility to receive funds under the Title IV, HEA programs. The Secretary of Education will continue to allow the institution's students enrolled in its programs of study to receive federal student aid during this 18 month period.
