OBC Accidental Stick Policy for Medical Assisting Students

- 1. Wash the area immediately with soap and water.
- 2. Alert the instructor right away.
- 3. Assist instructor with filling out an incident report.
- 4. Sign the incident report.
- 5. Both the "stickee" and the "sticker" should seek medical attention immediately from either the Health Department or Personal Physician for HIV and Hepatitis B Testing. The sticker should also receive consultation regarding prophylactic treatment.

OBC will not be responsible for charges incurred as a result of this incident. Each student is responsible for their own medical expenses. This applies to both in-school activities and during externship.
